

Workforce On-Boarding Hub

If you are a nonimmigrant student, scholar, staff and faculty member or a hiring manager for one and you are looking for assistance with Work Authorization you will need to work with the International Students and Scholars Office.

Departments are encouraged to consult with the International Students and Scholars Office <u>OIA</u> *before* committing to hiring an individual who are not a U.S. citizen or permanent resident.

<u>OIA</u> is available to talk with the candidate (either in person, if the candidate is on campus, or by phone or email) to <u>make sure</u> the immigration status selected best suits the scholar's immediate needs and plans.

This <u>comparison chart of employment-based visas</u> may assist you in making an initial visa determination.
